NATURE OF PROCEEDINGS: Complaint for Wrongful Death – Jury Trial – Day 34

The above-entitled cause comes on calendar this day for further jury deliberations. Court Attendant Lenore Venkus escorts the jurors to the deliberation room where deliberations resume at 9:25 a.m.

Communication is received that the jury has reached their verdict.

At 2:00 p.m., the parties assemble in the courtroom. Roger Dreyer is present with Plaintiffs William Strange and Ronald Sims. Collin Munro and David Barton are present on behalf of Donald Carlson for the Defense.

The jury enters the courtroom. The alternate jurors are present with the exception of alternate Maria Mercader whose presence is waived.

The Court confirms with the Foreperson that a verdict has been reached and confirms that each juror has signed a declaration stating they had not accessed electronic or wireless technology for case or attorney information. After examining the verdict, the Court instructs the Clerk to read it:
